## 1. Location

The IT School will take place on UCSD campus, in Atkinson Hall Auditorium.

Lodging, for those traveling to San Diego, is provided at the Warren Apartments. These are located in Warren College, UCSD.

## 2. Arrival

If you arrive in San Diego via San Diego International Airport, the best mode of transportation is by airport shuttle. On-campus parking is limited and we provide transportation to the off-campus social activity. If you must park on campus, you may purchase passes from the Warren apartments lobby.

## 3. Check-In

The best time to check-in (for lodging) is the evening of August 9<sup>th</sup>. If your travel arrangements necessitate an earlier check-in, please do not hesitate to arrive at your convenience. However, NASIT organizers will be available in the evening to assist students. If you intend to come after 10pm, you must arrange your check-in with the organizers (as the main lobby is closed).
